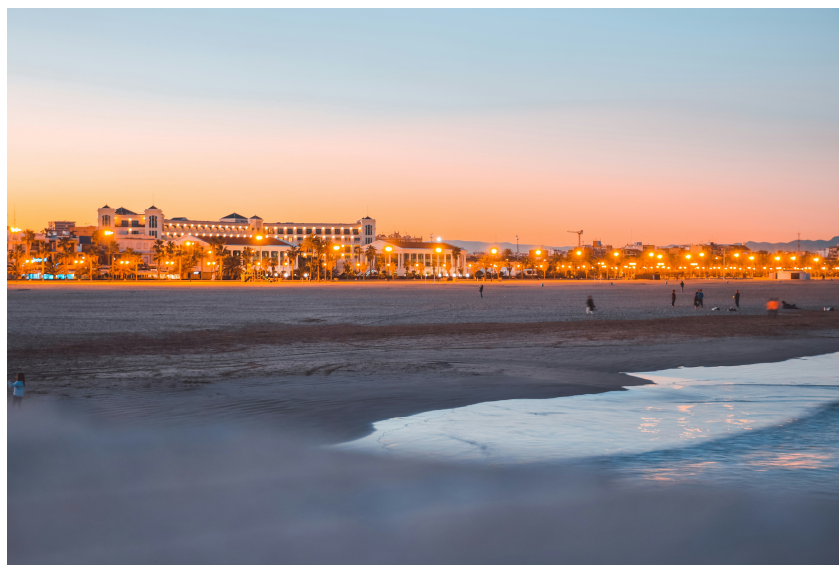

Professor Niki Panteli, PhD (Warwick), is a Professor of Digital Business at Lancaster University Management School and an Adjunct Professor at the Norwegian University of Science and Technology. She has an established international research record and has published on the topics of virtual collaborations and online communities, the implementation and evaluation of information systems, digital platforms and digital transformation. She led and participated in several research projects and her work appeared in numerous top-ranked academic journals including the Journal of the Association of Information Systems, The Journal of Strategic Information Systems, Work, Employment & Society, Information Systems Journal, European Journal of Information Systems, Human Relations, Information Technology and People, Decision Support Systems, Communications of the ACM and New Technology, Work and Employment among others. She served as the President for the UK Academy for Information Systems (UKAIS) for the period 2022 – 2024 and in 2025 was awarded the UKAIS Fellowship for her contributions to IS research, scholarship and teaching and to the UKAIS community. She is a Senior Editor for Information Systems Journal and has recently completed a 10-year term as a Senior Editor for Information Technology & People.

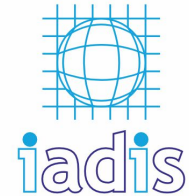
